

# Documentation to apply for Free Care:

## 1. Proof of Income , for example:

- Two weeks' worth of recent consecutive pay stubs
- Letter from the employer (with company name, name and signature of your supervisor, how many hours you work, and your total gross; salary paid)
- Most recent tax return (if self-employed).
- Proof If you receive any other benefits or support, e.g.:
  1. *Letter from Social Security or SSI (award letter)*
  2. *Child support documentation*
  3. *Unemployment stubs*
  4. *If you are unemployed and do not have any income, we will need a letter of the person whom is financially supporting you.*

## 2. Assets (applicants age 65 and over only), for example

- Bank checking or saving monthly statement
- Credit union monthly statement
- Life insurance monthly statement
- etc...(See your Health Benefit Counselor for more information)

## 3. Immigration/Citizenship Documentation

*If you are a .....*

- **Citizen** bring one the following (U.S. Passport, U.S. Birth Certificate, U.S. Citizen ID)
- **Legal permanent resident** bring one the following (Green Card or legal proof of residency)

## 4. Identity

- MA Photo ID or Driver License,
- Government issued identity card
- School Identity Card
- Passport
- If you are applying for a child under 16, please see HBC for more information.
